## Hospitality Coordinator & Team

The role of the **Hospitality Committee** is primarily of **making Manna Christian Fellowship a warm and welcoming place to all, with a focus on newcomers.** The Hospitality Committee demonstrates the love of Christ in tangible ways by embracing newcomers to Manna and helping them become integrated into the Fellowship. As with all of the leadership positions of Manna, this role is one of serving through love, which finds its source in the true vine of Jesus Christ.

**In addition to the general ST responsibilities, the Hospitality Committee has the following specific responsibilities:**

1. Set up and clean up Murray Dodge for Large Group.

The Hospitality Committee is in charge of making sure Murray Dodge is set up for Large Group. This responsibility includes setting up and cleaning up chairs, couches, Welcome Table, book table, refreshments table, and possibly aiding Praise Team with their equipment.

2. Greet and engage newcomers throughout Large Group, particularly during the beginning at the Welcome Table and during fellowship at the end.

The Hospitality Committee is in charge of helping newcomers get connected to the Fellowship via signups for Manna's fellowship-wide emails and to Small Groups.

3. Provide/schedule refreshments for Large Group.
4. Organize and distribute nametags as people arrive for Large Group.
5. Usher people to their seats.
6. Organize special activities to welcome newcomers such as beginning of the year events. (e.g., Pre-Frosh ice-cream social, the Activity Fair) and throughout the year (e.g., Friends' Night).
7. Think of and implement innovative ideas to engage newcomers.
