## Outreach Committee

Commensurate with Manna's purpose to develop and engage a Gospel Worldview, the vision of the **Outreach Committee** looks outward beyond the bounds of members of the fellowship. While what this looks like changes depending on how the Spirit is moving from year to year, aspects that remain constant include answering the call to evangelize, joining with other groups on campus for a shared cause, and recognizing the need for love and service beyond the bounds of "the Princeton bubble." As with all of the leadership positions of Manna, this role is one of serving through love, which finds its source in the true vine of Jesus Christ.

**In addition to the general ST responsibilities, the Outreach Committee has the following specific responsibilities (tentative):**

1. Attend bi-weekly outreach committee meetings.  
As a committee, come together to pray together, discuss events, and plan and delegate tasks.
2. Use evangelistic imagination to create events and opportunities, which demonstrates the Good News of the Gospel.

With staff approval and oversight, the outreach committee may form subcommittees to lead the organization and execution of different outreach events. Typically subcommittees are formed for events which require resources and manpower beyond the ability of the outreach committee. While events may change, these have included:

1. 5EEK Justice – the Justice Run & Campaign: An event dedicated to responding to the call to love others.
2. Emmaeus. Evangelistic surveys and personal witnessing opportunities.
3. GospelSpeak.
